River Brent Volunteering

ARA Venn is pleased to announce that on 24 November 2021, in conjunction with **Thames 21**, it participated in a **Vegetation Management Project** alongside the **River Brent**.

As part of the firm's ESG policy, we are proud to have adopted the '1-1-1' model, which means that 1% of each of our profits and people's time, on an annual basis, are given to support community causes, together with a pledge to be 100% carbon neutral.

As part of that commitment for this year, 13 team members recently gave their time to assist **Thames 21** with a project to improve the bankside next to the **River Brent** in **Perivale Park**. This was a physically demanding activity that involved 'scrub bashing', cutting back small trees, nettles and other plants in order to create a small path running alongside the river. Opening up areas along the river's bank encourages river vegetation, thereby improving the local ecosystem and benefitting wildlife whilst also providing greater access to the area for the local community to enjoy.

Thames 21 mobilises thousands of volunteers every year to clean and green the capital's 400-mile network of waterway, which provides a huge benefit to local communities, wildlife and the environment.
