ARA Venn is pleased to announce that on 11th August 2022, in conjunction with **Coram**, it participated in a second garden clean-up project.

As part of the firm's ESG policy, it is proud to have adopted the '1-1-1' model, which means that 1% of each of our profits and people's time, on an annual basis, is given to support community causes, together with a pledge to be carbon neutral.

This year, as part of that commitment, a team of 15 employees gave their time to assist Coram with the clean-up of their Creative Therapies Pears Pavillion play-area and surrounding gardens, at the site's headquarters at Brunswick Square. The work involved introducing lots of topsoil and bark chippings together with weeding and raking, all on a very hot day.
